

ADMISSION TO THE FACULTY OF FINE ARTS IN CETINJE

To complete the admission requirements, candidates have to be graduates of either any Vocational High School or the Grammar High School

As a prerequisite, eligible applicants are expected to have finished four-year courses at their High Schools

Necessary documents to be enclosed in order to take an entrance exam:

- application,
- original graduation certificate from the Grammar High School or the original graduation certificate from the Vocational High School,
- original certificates of the completed Secondary Education,
- copy of the identity card or the citizenship certificate and the birth certificate,
- diploma "Luča" or any other equivalent diploma of exceptional academic merits,
- diploma (or an equivalent document) awarded for winning the first or the second prize at the State High School competition organized by the Ministry of Education and Science or any other diploma awarded at higher rank competitions
- proof of a payment of €39,60 into the account no. 510-2171-26 (for the entrance examination)
- Map, 100 x 70 cm size, which must include:

THE PAINTING COURSE

- 3 drawings on the model – life size portraits
- 3 studies on the model – the whole figure
- 3 paintings (watercolor, tempera)
- 2 boards of the small format drawings (ink, pen, brush, pencil and the other drawing materials)
- a small drawing board – imagination

THE SCULPTURE COURSE

- 3 drawings on the model – life size portraits
- 3 studies on the model – the whole figure
- 2 sculptures – portrait (gypsum)
- 2 boards of the small format drawings (ink, pen, brush, pencil and the other drawing materials)
- a small drawing board – imagination

THE GRAPHICS COURSE

- 3 drawings on the model – life size portraits
- 3 studies on the model – the whole figure
- 2 paintings (watercolor, tempera)
- 2 boards of the small format drawings (ink – pen and brush);
- 2 boards of the small format drawings (pencil and the other drawing materials)
- a small drawing board – imagination

THE GRAPHIC DESIGN COURSE

- 2 drawings on the model – life size portraits;
- 2 studies on the model – the whole figure;
- 2 boards of the small format drawings (ink, pen, brush, pencil and the other drawing materials)
- a small drawing board – imagination
- one panel – 4 posters' creative ideas;
- one panel – 4-6 book design creative ideas;
- one panel – 8-10 typography works;
- one panel – 4-6 logo design creative ideas.

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAM

1. Test of general knowledge of art and culture
2. The practical part of the supplementary examination:

■ THE PAINTING COURSE

- The first day (8 hours): life model figure drawing
- The second day (6 hours): painting – still life
- The third day (6 hours): painting – still life

■ THE SCULPTURE COURSE

- The first day (8 hours): life model figure drawing
- The second day (6 hours): sculpture (portrait)
- The third day (6 hours): sculpture (portrait)

■ THE GRAPHICS COURSE

- The first day (8 hours): life model figure drawing
- The second day (6 hours): painting – still life
- The third day (6 hours): drawing test

■ THE GRAPHIC DESIGN COURSE

- The first day (8 hours): life model figure drawing
- The second day (6 hours): a small drawing (illustration and book design)
- The third day (6 hours): poster and logo design

EVALUATION AND SCORING

a) The final score in the individual classes (I, II, III, IV) is equalled to the average grade in all the classes of the High school, respectively

b) The Grammar High School external graduation exam or the Vocational High School external certification exam is scored as follows:

Excellent (5) – 12 points

Very good (4) – 9 points

Good (3) – 6 points

Satisfactory (2) – 3 points

**Persons who did not take an external graduation or certification exam can take the test in two subjects important for mastering the chosen program of studies, and thus achieve the appropriate number of points.*

The appointed examiners' panel asks questions, prepares tests and conducts evaluation upon the given answers.

The above mentioned test is assessed in completely the same way as the external graduation or certificate exam

c) Diploma "Luča 1" equals 5 points, whereas diploma „Luča 2" equals 3 points

d) The final grade in the Language and Literature as well as in the History of Art (in the III and IV class) is individually scored as follows:

Excellent (5) – 2.5 points

Very good (4) – 2 points

Good (3) – 1.5 points

Satisfactory (2) – 1 point

e) Test of general knowledge of art and culture is scored as follows:

Excellent (5) – 5 points

Very good (4) – 4 points

Good (3) – 3 points

Satisfactory (2) – 2 points

f) Scoring of the practical part of supplementary exam:

At the Painting and the Graphics course drawing and painting are assessed as follows:

grade (5) – 10 points

grade (4) – 7.5 points

Grade (3) – 5 points

Satisfactory (2) – 2.5 points

The same type of assessment is conducted for drawing and sculpture at the Sculpture course, as well as for drawing and design assignments at the Graphic design course.

According to the adopted criteria and rules, both phases of the supplementary exam (1 and 2) are eliminatory.

The first prize won at the competition in the subject important for mastering the study program is scored with two (2) points.

The second prize won at the competition in the subject important for mastering the study program is scored with one (1) point.
